*Moving forward with the new communications tower in the Cowlesville are (Old channel 49: tower) "Bennington Tower". Should be done by end of year.

*Monroe Services in Wyoming County (BLS-1/8a-8p) 7 days a week. This unit will be floating when available in the Varysburg/20A area. This unit is not jumping calls. This asset is to take some pressure off of the volunteer agencies during the day when staffing is an issue. This unit helps so we don't have to dispatch multiple agencies for a single basic call.

*Registration is a must for all classes!!! Use the new form "EOSB-1654" for any fire training. Or use EMS form for EMS related training. Put credentials and any other info on this form too.

*Materials are ordered & arriving for active shooter/MCI response bags (Waiting on back orders)

*Please remember that dispatch always sends law enforcement to mva's. YOU DO NOT HAVE TO ASK. OK TO ASK FOR ETA if needed for an emergency.

*Will be processing ID tags to get back up and running. These tags need to be used at incidents or the system will be closed out.

*Statewide firefighter survey update: get surveys back to WY-52 asap. Just 18 questions. Have 1-fire coordinator, 1-chief, 1-firefighter survey. Need to be in by October 31. Juniors need to be 16 or older. This is the time for you to express your thoughts, feelings, idea's, and concerns on what direction or corrective actions are needed for the Fire/EMS to survive in the very near future.

*Cancer bill update: Law goes into affect January 1, 2019. Chief's to come up with lists. Villages, towns, districts pay for this.
