*IAR update:

*Fire reporting is now active (?? start in 2019) up to speed-will pursue later in December if it is good with group, it will roll out then,.

*Enter all active responders in system

*Get your responders to use it properly

*Enter data for your agency

*If you need more in-depth training let Bill know.

*About a year and a half left on grant for this program so utilize it more. Was a 3 year program

*All messages are sent out on e-mails or text and not of IAR

*Monroe Services in Wyoming County (BLS-1 8a-8p.) 7 days a week. This unit will be floating when available. Usually in the Varysburg area. Use as needed. When the 10 minutes is up, they will come in the area. Not self-dispatching to calls

*FIT testing review: going forward. Completed about 5 departments so far. This is a requirement for cancer bill. Form needs to be filled out. Need it one week in advance.

*Burn tower use update: More departments scheduling use. Make out paperwork and remember that a Dept. Coordinator or State Instructor needs to be on location to facilitate.

*Registration is a must for all classes!!!! Use the new form EOSB-1654 for any fire training. Use the EMS registration form for all EMS classes. **MUST BE COMPLETED & SIGNED.**

*Materials are ordered and arriving for response bags (waiting on back orders) Most of the items have arrived. Will put together and get out.

*Please remember that dispatch always sends law enforcement to mva's. Police always get dispatched to the scene. PLEASE DO NOT ASK.

*ID tags: Decided to make new ones again. Promote them and use them how they were intended.

*Helmet grant program update: Approx. 700 would need it-share would be approx.. \$15.00 This was

brought up at County Association meeting by Brian Boorman who would work on a grant for state wide colored helmets or colored shields on the officer level, red for interior and green for exterior, to aid in accountability These would be seen 365%. Discussed it in depth. Motion made and seconded to keep the way it is and have each department police their own departments. Approved.

*Statewide Firefighter Survey update: sent out on e-mail. Only 4 Chief's replied and 119 firefighters responded. Push them to do so. Fill out on paper if no computer.

*Cancer Bill update: received 3 prices, VFIS at \$137.00, ESIP at \$174.00 and Hartford Ins. Co.(preferred) at \$166.63 per firefighter. Will be up to your fire districts, commissioners, villages etc.

University of Rochester and are supposed to notify Emergency Services to let them know these are in the area.
